IS YOUR HORSE PROTECTED?

Mosquitoes across Massachusetts and in surrounding states spread Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) and West Nile Virus (WNV).

In 2019, eight horses in Massachusetts died from EEE. In 2020, interventions including vaccination eliminated cases of EEE in horses!

Vaccination can prevent EEE and WNV in horses. Protect your horses!

Call your veterinarian to schedule this life-saving vaccination.
